

Tycoon International Enterprise Competition Costs

We ask fee-paying schools to contribute to the cost of the competition with an annual licence fee of £2,500 per school. This cost covers:

Join an exclusive Tycoon league – during the trading period, students will be able to monitor their profit and return on investment against other businesses in their school, region or internationally



Tycoon International comes with a good will loan guarantee of up to £500 per school – schools administer the loans associated with Tycoon and, at the end of the competition, PJF will refund up to £500 per school should there be student businesses who register a loss in their final report/evaluation.



The platform comes with 6 video-based masterclasses and 6 video-based Flash Challenges developed in collaboration with PJF's network of businesses and entrepreneurs, to supplement the programme and support the development of enterprise skills.



The platform comes with resources to support learners for whom English is a second language with a focus of formal and business English



Schools taking part will receive a termly newsletter with business tips and Tycoon news from across the world.



Schools taking part will have the opportunity to attend termly live webinars with entrepreneurs where students can ask questions directly to the speaker. Schools who are unable to attend live will receive a recording



The platform comes with case studies of previous Tycoon businesses and resources that support with idea generation.



The platform comes with materials to promote Tycoon in school, including an assembly pack with a video message from Peter Jones CBE



All students completing Tycoon International receive a certificate.



The top three teams in each section of the competition will be invited to a Tycoon Ceremony at Royal Hampton Court Palace in the Autumn, hosted by Peter Jones CBE and attended by other leading entrepreneurs and investors
